The application is the NetApp ONTAP System Manager formerly OnCommand System Manager web application.

### **Notes**

### **Evaluation Methods Used**

Assistive technology products used as part of testing included Freedom Scientific JAWS 2018, NVDA 2017.4, Freedom Scientific MAGic 14.0, Al Squared ZoomText 11, Dragon NaturallySpeaking 13, Microsoft Windows accessibility features, and keyboard-only control. Testing was performed with this assistive technology on Edge, Chrome and Firefox on Windows 10.
