Swam world’s best time since 2017 in 100m breaststroke

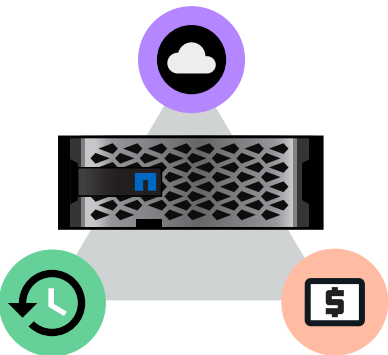
At 24 years old, King holds three of the top eight swim times in history. She set the world record for the 100m breaststroke at 1:04.13 and is a favorite for the 2021 games.
